Please note:

When driving on the continent it is compulsory to carry a warning triangle, spare bulb kit, yellow safety vest, headlamp converter kit, fire extinguisher and first aid kit. You will also need to have a country of origin sticker visible on the back of your vehicle. It is compulsory to carry snow chains in the Alps and it is often a good idea to have with you spare gloves, a torch and a blanket.



Driving to Ardent - Directions

It is approximately 550 miles from Calais to Ardent. The most direct route is via the toll roads.

Please note that when driving on the continent it is compulsory to carry a warning triangle, spare bulb kit, yellow safety vest, headlamp converter kit, fire extinguisher and first aid kit. You will also need to have a country of origin sticker visible on the back of your vehicle. It is compulsory to carry snow chains in the Alps and it is often a good idea to have spare gloves, a torch and a blanket with you.

From Calais, follow the A16/A26 Paris, after approx. 4 miles take the A26 signed Paris/Reims/Arras. Follow the A26 taking the Reims then Lyon signs.

After approx. 257 miles take the A5 following signs to Dijon/Lyon. After 50 miles take the A31 signed Dijon/Lyon. Follow the signs to Geneva.

When approaching Geneva follow the signs to Chamonix A40 and continue to the Cluses turn off (NOT LA CLUSAZ).

Leave the A40 at the Cluses junction and follow the D902 via Taninges and Les Gets to Morzine.

Upon arrival into Morzine, take the right hand turn onto the D338 direction Morzine/Avoriaz. Follow this road into the town ignoring the signpost on your right for Avoriaz and continue left, past the tourist office (large car park opposite on your right).

Follow the road down the hill along the one-way system past Intersport until you come to the roundabout at the Mairie (Town Hall) opposite the church. From here it is 8 km.

Turn left, direction Thonon D228, towards Montriond. Continue past the footbridge on your left hand side and on into Montriond Village.

Just after the church you will see the Mairie (Town Hall) on the right hand side – turn right and follow the signs for Lac de Montriond, Ardent and Les Lindarets.

Turn right at the small roundabout and continue straight up the hill. Go past the lake and carry on up the hill, Ardent is the village just after you exit from the avalanche tunnel.

Driving to Les Coches - Directions

It is approximately 650 miles from Calais to Les Coches. The most direct route is via the toll roads.

From Calais, follow the A16/A26 Paris. After approx. 4 miles take A26 signed Paris/Reims/Arras.

Follow the A26 taking the Reims then Lyon signs.

After approx. 257 miles take the A5 following signs to Dijon/Lyon.

After 50 miles take A31 signed Dijon/Lyon, follow the signs to Lyon.

You will then need to pick up the signs for Chambéry.

Take the A43 to Chambéry /Albertville, then follow the blue signs to Albertville (not the RN Albertville).

Carry on road through Albertville following signs for Moutiers for about 24km.

After junction 38, get in the left-hand lane for Haute Tarentaise/Aime/Bourg St.Maurice. You will immediately go through a small tunnel. Continue on this road.

Follow the signs for Aime and Bourg St.Maurice, NOT La Plagne. 7 km after Aime you will see signs for Montchavin/Les Coches (D87).

Take that right turning and follow the road down to the valley floor, over a bridge, over a railway line and up into the village of Landry. Turn right for Montchavin/Les Coches (D220). After 250m follow the road on to the D225 and you will begin to climb the hill. Continue past Montchavin until you arrive into Les Coches.

Please note that the driveway up to the chalet's parking area is quite steep. If conditions are icy, it is advisable to leave your car in a parking space on the road and not to attempt the driveway. If in doubt then please walk up the drive to the chalet and ask a member of staff to help.

Driving to Reberty - Directions

It is approximately 650 miles from Calais to Reberty. The most direct route is via the toll roads.

From Calais, follow the A16/A26 Paris.

After approx. 4 miles take A26 signed Paris/ Reims/Arras. Follow the A26 taking the Reims then Lyon signs. After approx. 257 miles take the A5 following signs to Dijon/Lyon.

After 50 miles take A31 signed Dijon/Lyon, follow the signs to Lyon. You will then need to pick up the signs for Chambéry.

Take the A43 to Chambéry /Albertville, then follow the blue signs to Albertville (not the RN Albertville). Carry on the road through Albertville following signs for Moutiers for about 24km.

After junction 38, get in the right-hand lane. You will need junction 40, which is just after a tunnel opening on the opposite side of the road just after a 70km/h sign. Follow the signs for St. Martin de Belleville/Les Menuires/Val Thorens.

Continue up this road until you arrive at Les Menuires (27 km). Go under a bridge (with a piste on it) and at the roundabout take the second exit to Reberty, NOT Val Thorens. Pass the big millenium monument on your right and carry on up the hill. The road continues past Reberty-1850 Centre Commercial on the right.

Continue up through the hairpins until you see a wooden building called 'La Tetras Lyre' on the right hand side of a left hairpin. Our chalets are located in the complex 50 metres up on the right from this hairpin. If you arrive at Chalet 2000 or 'Club Med' or 'MGM' then you have gone too far.

Please note that parking is not permitted within the Reberty complex where our chalets are located, however you may park to upload your luggage. Family Ski Company has spaces allocated in a private underground car park situated between Chalets Genevieve and Claudia, and we recommend that you prebook a car park space with us if you are driving to Reberty. Parking is limited so please book your space early.
